The Bow River Basin Council will be hosting a full-day Science Forum in the Macdonald Hall at the Southern Alberta Institute of Technology (SAIT) (Calgary, Alberta) on Wednesday, May 03, 2017.

The purpose of the Forum is to increase awareness of watershed-related research and projects in the Bow River Watershed. We encourage submissions on all research topics of relevance to the Bow River basin. Potential topics for the 2017 Science Forum include but are not limited to the following:

1. State of the Watershed

e.g., surface and groundwater quality/quantity, riparian health, biological communities

2. Threats to Human Health and Aquatic Ecosystems

e.g., emerging contaminants, invasive species, algal blooms, climate change

3. Innovative Methods of Aquatic Assessment

e.g., novel technology or methods, pilot projects

4. Connecting Science to Action

e.g., wetlands restoration, best management practices, source water protection, green architecture

We invite abstract submissions for oral presentations on any of the above topics, and strongly encourage student submissions. Oral presentations are approximately 15 minutes in length.
